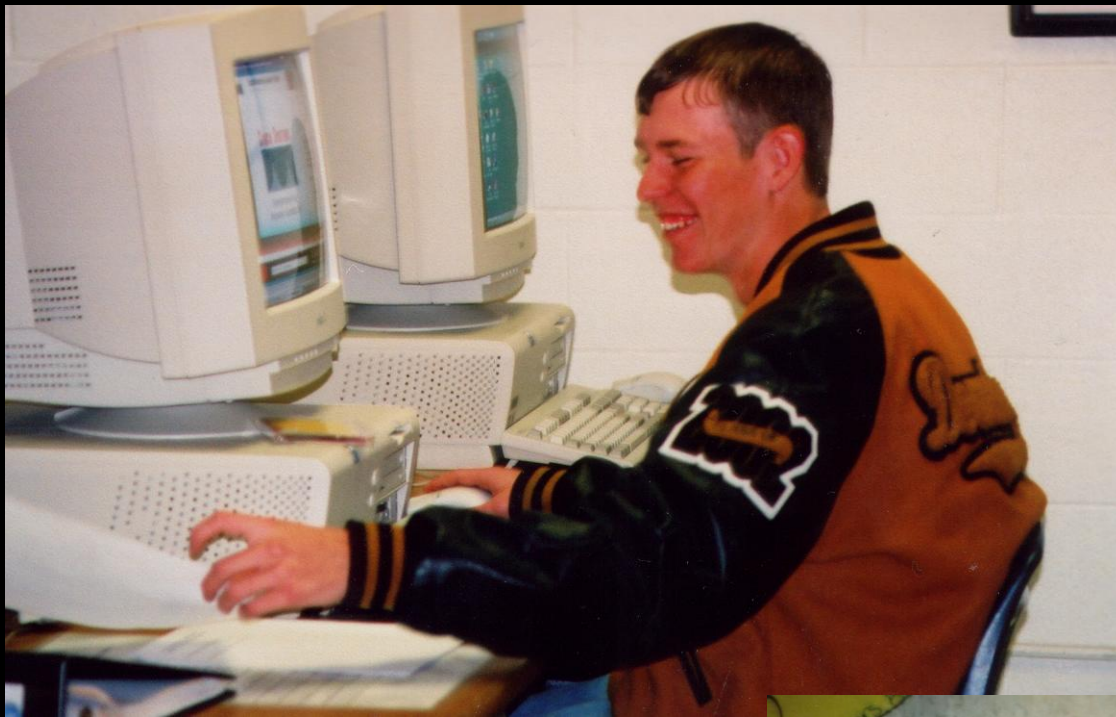

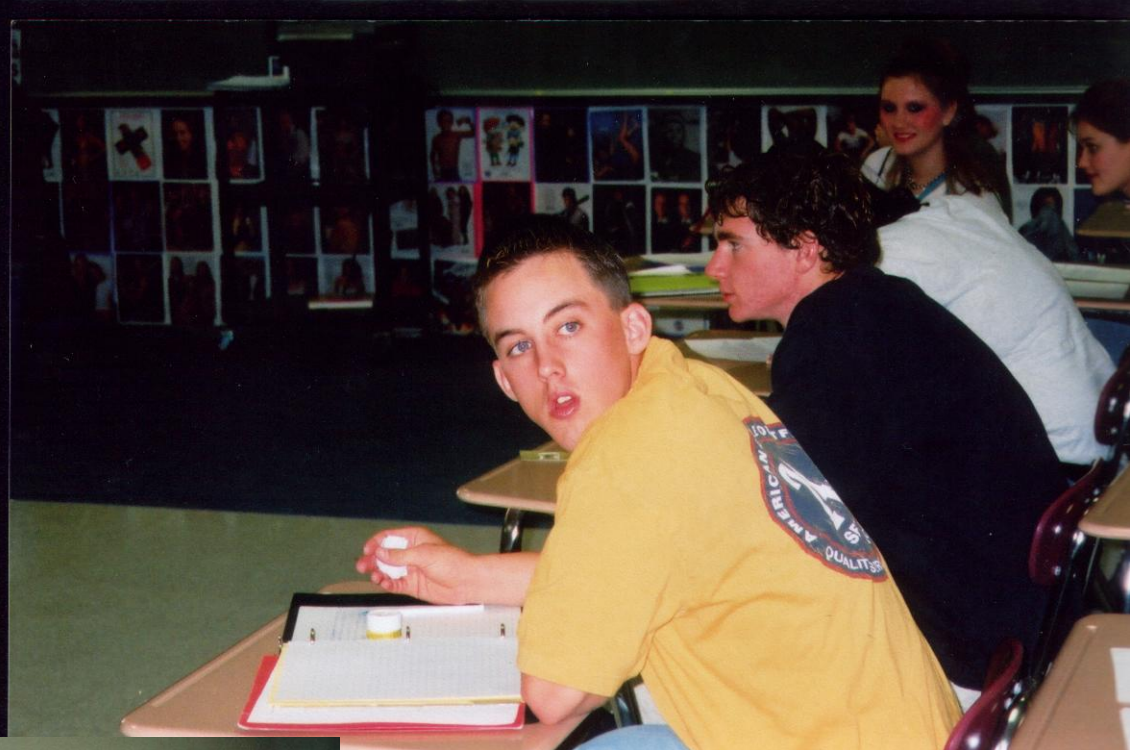

Tips -- Know your surroundings!

Look at the following before pressing the button

1. Background- Is there anything distracting?
2. Lighting- Will there be a glare or a bad shadow?
3. Rule of thirds- Place your subject in a hot spot
4. Leading lines- Lead your photo toward subject
5. Patterns- Are there any patterns you can include?
6. Anticipate- Have a feeling for where the action is going to happen.

Tips -- Know your surroundings!

Look at the following before pressing the button

7. Be ready for anything- Always have your camera
8. Make mistakes- Don't be afraid to try new things
9. Look for ideas- Check out magazines, books, and the web for new ideas
10. Know your equipment- Don't look like a fool when you can't get your camera to work!
