4. After you have viewed all the pictures and have read all of the captions, you will need to answer the following questions in essay form. Be as thorough as possible, citing specific examples from the photo essay.
 - What do you think was the overall purpose for this photographer to choose these subjects to highlight in a photo essay?
 - What picture moved you the most and why?
 - What picture was the most disturbing to you and why?
 - How do you think the people highlighted in the photo essay were affected by having their story told through pictures?
 - Do think any social change was promoted by this essay and why?
 - What was the message of this essay?
 - Name at least five different storytelling elements (theme, plot, character, setting, etc.) present in this photo essay AND explain how Kenneally displayed each (cite specific examples please).
 - What emotions were central in this photo essay? Explain with examples.
